#### A FEW REMINDERS...

Water and sewer customers, the new year is upon us. Do you need to update your account information? Many customers have outdated contact information in our records. If you have changed phone numbers, please contact us. Thank you!

**City Water Shut Offs** 

Please note: It is illegal for unauthorized persons to touch City water shut offs for any reason. If you are having water problems contact City Hall at 245-6941, emergency contact instructions are given by recording after hours.

**Water Bill Payment Due Dates** 

Monthly water bills for water services shall be due and payable on the first day of the month following the close of the billing period, and shall be delinquent if not paid within fifteen (15) days from that date. Upon delinquency, a penalty of ten (10) percent of the balance due for that billing period shall be charged. When the water service is disconnected for nonpayment of any bill, service shall not resumed until all prior charges have been paid in full, including the late penalty plus a twenty-five dollar (\$25.00) reconnection charge 14.08.110 (Municipal Code of Plymouth, CA is subject to change)

Meter Reading and the Safety of City Employees

Meter reading occurs approximately the 15th of each month depending on
the day of the week. For the safety of City employees, please limit animals
access to the meter boxes during this time. Thank you for your cooperation.

#### Have you registered for Code Red yet???

It is just a few simple questions and takes just minutes to complete online at **www.cityofplymouth.org** (scroll down to the bottom left hand corner of our home page and click on the CodeRed logo). If you do not have internet access, you can come into City Hall and fill out a very short questionnaire and staff will enter you into the system. It is important to register, **CodeRed is the City's emergency alert system** and those not registered will not receive important messages regarding health and safety issues.
