The Amador County Health Department Guidelines for Public Swimming Pools must be strictly enforced. This includes proper handwashing, social distancing, the wearing of cloth face coverings when not swimming, temperature assessment before entering the pool area, limiting the number of swimmers in the pool, and the daily tracking of attendance. Patrons not following these COVID-19 requirements will be asked to leave.

**CLOSURE POLICY** The Amador County Health Codes dictates that the pool will be closed due to COVID -19 outbreak or fecal contamination. Pool will be closed on poor air quality days and during lightning storms.

## POOL REMINDERS

Anyone under 18 will need to be accompanied by a parent or guardian, so that a waiver can be signed.

Anyone with long hair must restrain their hair with a swim cap or ponytail/braid to protect the pools drain and filtration system. Cotton shirts and cut off shorts are not allowed.

Please bring your own chairs, blankets or towels to sit on, as chairs will no longer be provided. Shade sails are up for when you want to take a break from the sun.

**Babies & toddlers are required to wear swim diapers. No sanitary napkins are allowed in the pool.**
