New ways to pay your Utility Bill

The City has been working on improvements to utility bills for several months. *You can now make payments online using a bank account or credit card on the City's website at www.cityofplymouth.org. There is no additional fee for making payments using this method. You will need the "WEB ID" from the bill which is located on the right-hand side under "Office Use." Account numbers are located at the top of the bill, and are needed when making a payment by check. You may also create an online account for automatic payments or to make payments on multiple accounts. Please contact the City Office with any questions.*

The City of Plymouth has a program where eligible citizens affected by the COVID-19 pandemic can receive assistance on their City Water/Sewer bills, as well as PG&E and broadband internet bills.
