NOTICE is hereby given that on January 20, 2022, at 6:30 P.M., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, the Planning Commission of the City of Plymouth will hold a public hearing at Plymouth City Hall, located at 9426 Main Street, Plymouth, CA, 95669, to consider the following actions:

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT, under Government Code Section 65400, the City of Plymouth Planning Commission will hold a public meeting to receive public comments on and make a recommendation to the City Council on Amending Chapter 19.84.040D, Sales from Trucks, and 19.98, Glossary, of Title 19 of the Plymouth Municipal Code.

The project is a city-initiated amendment to Title 19, Zoning, of the City of Plymouth Municipal Code (PMC) to modify regulations on mobile vendors, including without limitations, adding definitions and changing the permits required. The project, which is amending Chapter 19.84.040D, Sales from Trucks, and Chapter 19.98, Glossary, of the PMC Title 19.

All persons interested in this matter may attend the public meeting or participate remotely as set forth in the agenda to be posted by the City at least 72 hours prior to the above-mentioned hearing time, and may present any comments deemed relevant to the amendments proposed to Title 19 of the Plymouth Municipal Code, amending Chapters 19.84 and 19.98.
