Customers of Plymouth were notified on 12/15/2021 and again on 03/16/2022 that the water system failed the Stage 2 Disinfection By-Product Rule for the 4th quarter of 2021 and 1st quarter of 2022. Specifically, that the Total Trihalomethanes (TTHMs) were above the maximum contamination level (MCL). **We are pleased to report that the problem has been corrected and we are no longer in violation of this exceedance.** The samples taken May 17, 2022 brought the Locational Running Average (LRAA) back in compliance.
