The City of Plymouth is seeking a **Maintenance Worker I or Maintenance Worker II**, who under general supervision from the Public Works Director, performs a variety of skilled, semi-skilled, and unskilled activities. We have one full-time and one part-time position available.

## **The Position**

The **Maintenance Worker I** class is a journey level in the City maintenance services. Duties and responsibilities range from performing ditch maintenance, carpentry tasks, constructing, repairing, installing, maintaining City parks, buildings, streets, sidewalks, fences to cleaning City public facilities, and performs other duties as required.

The **Maintenance Worker II** class is the advanced journey level in the City maintenance and operational services. The class is distinguished from the Maintenance Worker I by requiring greater initiative, judgment, responsibility, autonomy and discretion in planning and completing a wide variety of maintenance and operational activities. The incumbent in this position has day-to-day responsibility for assigned projects and operations.

## **Qualifications**

Experience and education to successfully perform the duties of a Maintenance Worker I or Maintenance Worker II. A typical way of obtaining the required qualifications is to possess the equivalent of a High School diploma and four years of related maintenance experience from a public agency.

## **Licensing Requirements:**

- Valid Class C California driver's license by date of appointment. A Class B California driver's license may be required for some positions.
- Required licenses and certifications must be kept current during employment with the City.

## **Selection Procedure**

Candidates must submit application materials that include a completed and signed employment application and copies of any required certificates or license listed under the requirements.
