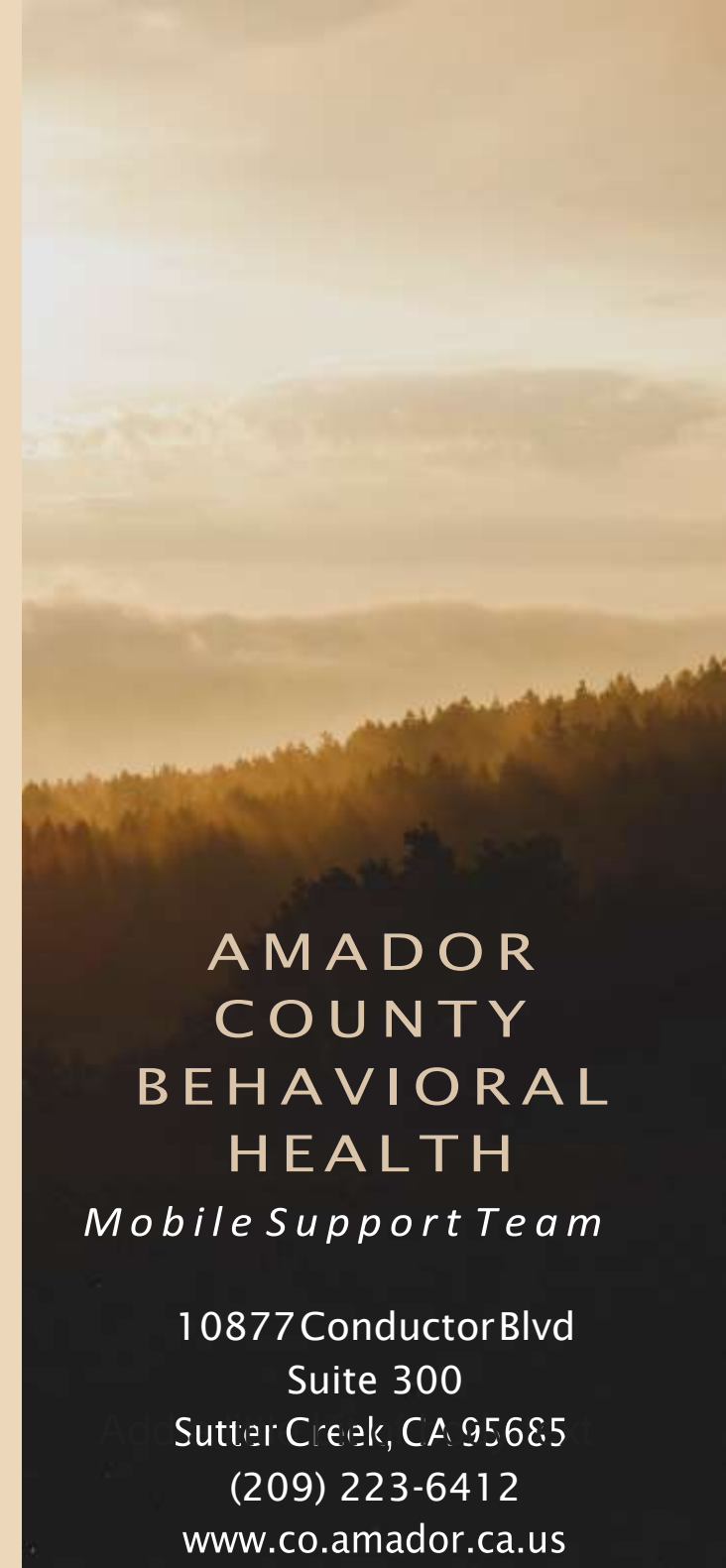

OUR PURPOSE

The purpose of the Mobile Support Team is to provide supportive services to prevent hospitalization and re-hospitalization.

GOALS

- Provide field based supportive services within 7 days of discharge from an inpatient psychiatric facility.
- Provide supportive services following an evaluation and safety plan to provide additional support to help prevent hospitalization.
- Provide intake assessments in the field as appropriate to reduce barriers to accessing services.
- Provide Wellness Recovery Action Plan (WRAP).
- Provide information regarding community resources and supports.

PROCESS

Under supervision of the Behavioral Health Director, the Mobile Support Team provides mental health services and supports to individuals at their home or in the field. These services may include, but are not limited to the following situations:

- Follow up with clients who are seen in the Emergency Department and do not meet the criteria for a 5150 hold, but mobile support services are part of the safety plan.
- Clients being discharged from an acute psychiatric facility.
- Clients that frequently access crisis services or in need of immediate mental health supportive services.
