

A note from Margaret Roberts, Plymouth City Manager

July is here, fireworks are coming, time to celebrate our independence. Trucks, Tractors, and Trikes Parade on the 4th starting at 10 AM starting on Sherwood Street. Just show up and be in the parade. Food in the park at 6:00pm and Music in the park at 7:00pm. "Safe and Sane" Fireworks only begin at dusk and end by 10:00pm on Main Street.

The County Fair is just around the corner at the end of the month! I can't wait to watch my grandson show his rabbits.

Highlights of the June Council meetings include the following:

- Approved minutes for two previous meetings
- Received the May Warrant Register
- Presented the 2024/25 budget
- Discussed Request for Qualifications/Proposal for Law Enforcement Services
- Approved new IT services contract with ABSO Technologies
- Provided direction to staff regarding services for animal control
- Called the Election for November 5th for the City Council, City Clerk and City Treasurer
- Put Ballot Measures on the November 5th Election proposing to change the City Clerk and City Treasurer from Elected positions to Appointed positions.
- Provided a list of projects for Fiscal year 2024-25 eligible from SB1, The Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 approximately \$36,691.
- Approved changing the Senior Accountant position from part-time to full-time
- Approved the continuing appropriations and expenditures resolution
- Approved the sale of "Safe and Sane" fireworks and the use on the 4th of July on Main Street only
- Report on Public Works May Activities, Code Enforcement May activities
- Report on the Fire Station Improvement Project Work

Starting August 21st, the City will be switching to a new pay system for water/sewer billing. It will be directly connected to the Utility Billing software, so your payment will be applied to your account within 30 minutes instead of the following day. If you currently use automatic payment you will need to sign up again for this new system. You will be able to sign up on the City website or see Tracy in the Finance office in City Hall for help. We encourage our customers to sign up for automatic payment, it is easy and safe to use.

The Plymouth Veterans Memorial Pool is a great place to stay cool in this warm weather. Pool hours are 1:30 – 6:30. It is located on Sherwood Street adjacent to the Fairgrounds across from the Fire Station and Community Garden. It is the best pool in Amador County!

There is also a Bluegrass Music Festival coming to the Amador County Fairgrounds from October 9-13.

The City Council ad hoc committee is working with a landscape architect on the McGee/Sharkey Park Grant to come up with the ultimate project or projects to do.
