A note from Margaret Roberts, Plymouth City Manager

Sounds of September will bring the month in on Saturday with music, food and fun!

At the August meetings the City Council took the following actions:

- Appointed Gail Shaw to the Planning Commission
- Received a list of contracts signed by the City Manager in the fourth quarter of fiscal year 2023/24
- Received the July Warrant register
- Authorized an amendment to the Professional Service Agreement with CSG Consultants, Inc. for the completion of Environmental Consulting Services and associated technical studies for ARCO Car Wash and Gas Station.
- Introduced an ordinance amending the Plymouth Municipal Code regarding Permits
- Introduced an ordinance amending the Plymouth Municipal Code regarding smoking/vaping prohibition in City parks
- Introduced an ordinance amending the Plymouth Municipal Code regarding discontinuation of water service for nonpayment
- Adopted a resolution approving assignment of the Franchise and Contract for solid waste handling services within the City of Plymouth to Delta Container Corp/Republic Services
- Received a presentation from the City Council Ad Hoc Committee regarding the McGee/Sharkey Park Grant Renovations. Direction was given to have a table at the Farmer's Market to obtain public input on the renderings, along with the already scheduled public input meeting on Saturday.
- City Council appointed Council Member Amoruso to be the voting delegate at the League of California Cities conference in October.
- Approved the minutes of the June 27 th and August 8th meetings
- Authorized the Sheriff's Contract Ad Hoc Committee to negotiate a law enforcement services contract with Amador County Sheriff's Office
- Approved the final design for the McGee/Sharkey Park Improvements with the City Manager's changes for the hardscape and the landscape to come back when the estimate for the work is received. TOT funds were authorized to subsidize the grant funds for the excess expense over the grant funds.

The City had the playground equipment inspected and everything passed. The City requested this inspection because we wanted to make sure all of the equipment was still in excellent condition for the safety of our children.

The final drawing for the McGee/Sharkey Park Improvements is being completed. We will be putting them online for ease of public access. When they are posted we will get that news out on social media.

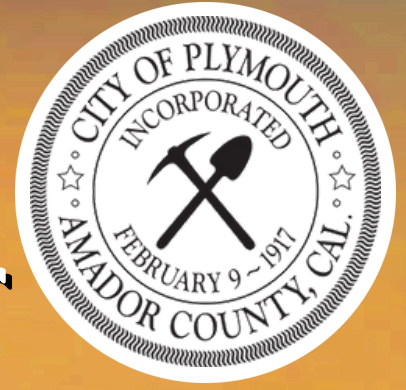
