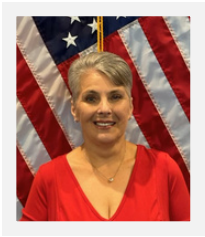


Reminder: Work on your property may require a Building Permit

A note from the City Manager, Margaret Roberts.

There has been a lot of rain since February began! Preparations for winter storms have started and a peaceful winter is what I'm praying for. Although it's a while off, please put April 12th on your calendar for Spring Family Fun Day. There will be free hotdogs at McGee Park, games with prizes, and exhibitors to visit. Rain or shine, it's going to happen. Because of the weather last year, we had to shift into City Hall, so we will do that again if needed.

Highlights of the January Council meeting include the following:

- Made appointment to the Planning Commission.
- Approved the minutes of the December 18, 2024, meeting.
- Received the December Warrant Register.
- Approved the first amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with CSG Consultants, Inc., to complete environmental documents for the ARCO Gas Station.
- Amended the Municipal Code regarding Hen Coop, Residential and related minor modifications to Title 19, Zoning to allow the keeping of hens.
- Approved the Negative Declaration for the City's 6th Cycle Housing Element
- Adopted a General Plan Amendment repealing the 5th Cycle Plymouth Housing Element
- Council discussed burn permits and asked for an ordinance to come back with changes

On January 30th, the Fire Station Improvement Project had its grand opening. The job is finished except for the carpet installation, and there was a good turnout.



The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) received the Housing Element once it was approved by the City Council. HCD's review is presently in progress.

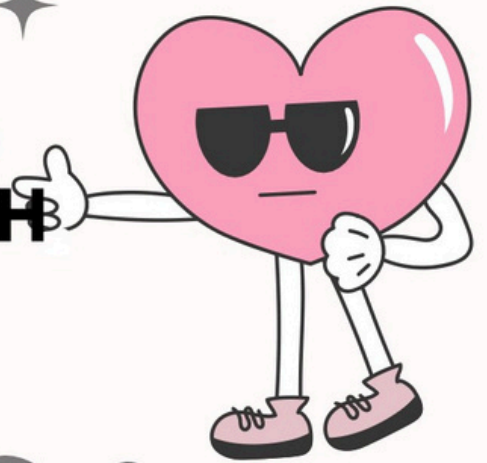
Planning is working on the 2024 General Plan and Housing Element Annual Progress Report (APR), which will be presented to the Planning Commission on February 20 as an informal item. The City Council will then examine it. The APRs will be sent to HCD as needed after City Council assessment.

CalTrans has met with the City and Plymouth Foothill Rotary to discuss connecting their walkway to the Veteran's Park pathway in preparation for the Mid-April commencement of the HWY 49 trail project. Soon, concrete pathways that comply with ADA standards will be built across Veteran's Park. Public Works will finish the Veteran's Park fence to extend to Locust Street, weather permitting and wood availability. The January employee of the month is Tracy Pitts from Finance. Congratulate her on a job well done if you see her. Tracy puts a lot of effort into maintaining and assisting the public at the front counter in Finance. She has arranged the paperwork there and the supply storage room.

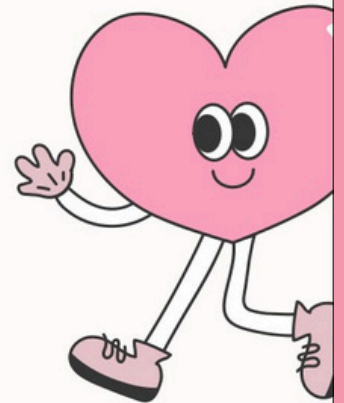
